

- Created the company's only booking system for sales and ad display management system. •
- Converted the company to use platform events and an eventbus logging system as opposed to • future callouts.
- Trained multiple senior developers on the team how to use our system and documented useful information for any newcomers for the team.
- Built Multiple LWCs including one for creating opportunities for specific scenarios and another for associating generic objects to a parent object which were then sent to an exterior system.
- Revamped the companies entire integration system between salesforce and their budgeting system
- Created a custom LWC for displaying and editing push topics as well a live monitor for viewing • them as the objects are edited.
- Developed an asynchronous service that accounts for specific custom settings and user • permissions to send over 65 fields to another system with more than 5 nested child objects
- Built and set up a salesforce API to integrate with Looker Accounts
- Developed a generic platform event receiver service to confirm changes made by exterior systems to interior Salesforce back to the salesforce system
